Thacher wine is produced with all native yeast and bacteria, minimal amounts of effective SO₂, and is crafted without added enzymes, water, acids, tannins, or nutrients. These wines are all single varietal, vineyard designated, and from small lots. Our low intervention wine making process allows these wines to be created in the vineyard.

We are thrilled to present our first estate Cabernet Sauvignon. Notes of fresh mint, black cherry and dusty cigar box effortlessly move you to a palate bursting with the complexities of vanilla bean, violet and chocolate. Sage, oregano and black pepper prevail on the finish of this well-balanced wine, along with hints of leather and red fruit.

Another first for Thacher. An intoxicating nose of baking spices, lavender, tobacco and a mix of candy-like red fruits and darker, intense red fruits leads to a palate of savory cinnamon, ripe cranberry and chalky minerality. Moderate, sandy tannins and refreshing acidity provide for a lengthy and memorable finish.

The second of our new wines, and with a particularly muddled heritage, Cabernet Pfeffer is truly a mystery. Originally thought to be a fusion of Cabernet Sauvignon and possibly Trousseau, it has since been found by U.C. Davis to be genetically identical to the Bordeaux variety Mourtaou. The aromatic journey begins with an enticing blend of red current and wild strawberry, complemented by herbaceous notes of rosemary and tomato leaf. On the palate you will find notes of cranberry and white pepper. Elevate your experience by decanting this bright and perfumed wine or enjoy it with a slight chill.

Notes of bright, red cherry, black plum, clove and tart cranberry usher in an earthiness on the palate of tea, pomegranate and thyme. A peppery finish with subtle spice is balanced with mouthwatering acidity and delicate tannins.

2021 VACCARÈSE

From the Rhone valley, with aromas of cherry cola, tea, bay leaf and vanilla bean, this wine explodes on the palate with red, ripe plum, cocoa powder, and juicy cherry. Present vibrant tannins contribute to the lengthy finish of spice and white pepper.
