TASTING NOTES

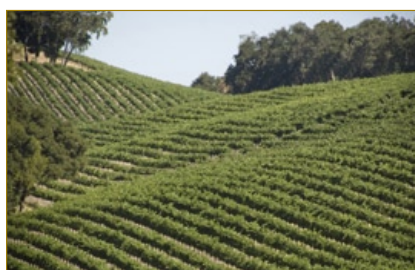
This wine is clear and bright, with a medium intense garnet core fading to pale garnet with a water white rim. On the nose, this wine is clean and has just begun developing, with medium intense aromas of ripe blackberry, black cherry, boysenberry liquor, black plums, vanilla bean, Mediterranean spice, garrigue, herbs, and toffee.

On the palate, this wine is dry, with a rich silken body, medium plus spicy alcohol, medium fine tannin, medium acid and medium plus flavors of ripe boysenberry, black cherry, plums, cocoa powder, vanilla cream, baking spice and oak. The finish is medium plus in length, with lingering ripe flavors supported by spicy alcohol and fine tannin.

This wine is ready to drink, but will develop more complexity with another 6-10 months of bottle time. It will hold for another 2-4 years, and would pair wonderfully with cumin spiced lamb, bone-in rib eye or hearty stew.
