TASTING NOTES

This wine is clear and very bright, with a medium intense ruby core fading to a water-white rim. Legs are present and are fast and thin.

On the nose, this wine is clean and developing. Its aromas are medium plus intense and very fresh. They include cherry jam, red currants, cranberry, dried cranberry, raisins, vanilla beans and oak.

On the palate, this wine is dry. It has medium fully ripe tannin, medium plus brisk acidity, medium body and medium plus integrated alcohol. The flavors are medium plus intense and include red cherry, raspberry, jolly ranchers, red currants, dried cranberry, vanilla cream, oak spice and dried roses. The finish is long and displays impeccable balance between ripe fruit flavors, fresh acid and fine ripe tannins. This is a delicious wine and is ready to drink now. It will hold for 2-3 years before it loses its youthful freshness, but may continue to develop additional complexity of aroma and flavor for another few years past this.
