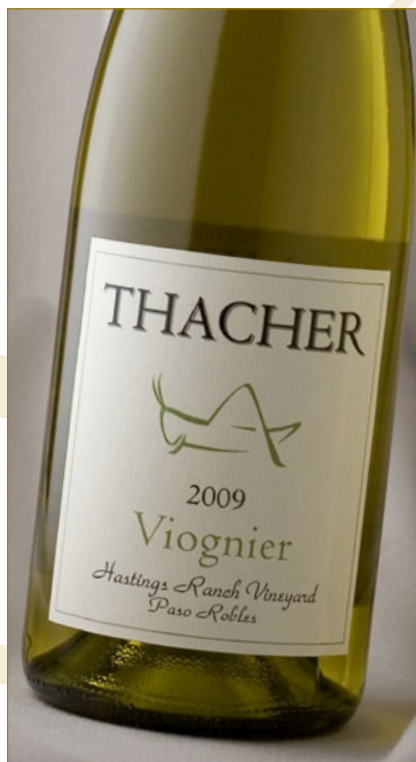

### VINEYARD PROFILE

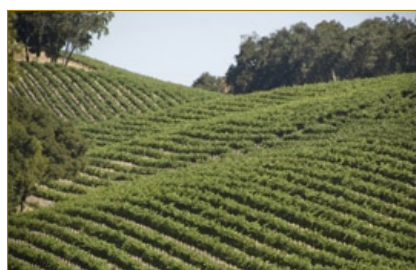
Located in the heart of Adelaida, amongst the highest elevation vineyards in the region. Small berries, split lyre trellis farming for super premium wine grapes. Only 2.8 acres of viognier planted in this 40 acre vineyard.

### TASTING NOTES

This wine is clear and bright with a medium intense lemon colored core and golden rim. Legs are thick and slow to form.

On the nose, this wine is clean and has just begun developing. Its aromas are medium plus intense and include golden apples, brioche, lemon peel, honey, summer wheat, honeysuckle and flinty minerals.

On the palate, this wine is dry, with a medium plus very rich body, medium acid, medium plus integrated alcohol, and medium plus flavors of Eureka lemons, lemon peel, ripe golden apple, honey, cream, baking spice, yellow flowers, and caramel. The finish is medium plus in length, and carries with it ripe fruit flavors, supporting acid and wonderful viscosity. This wine is ready to drink, and should hold for 1-2 years while fruit and acid are fresh.
