Notes of apple pie and honeycomb lead you to a palate of wet stone minerality, apricot, white peach and both Meyer lemon and grapefruit rind. The finish is fresh, long and silky with a slightly briny edge. This weighty winter white begs a place on your Thanksgiving table. Cellar 2025-2027.

### **2018 CONTROLLED CHAOS**

**37% Mourvèdre, 27% Zinfandel, 18% Grenache, 18% Counoise**

With aromas of bright strawberries, Rainier cherries and pluots, this wine is bursting with boysenberry, raspberry and red plum fruits as well as a subtle damp earthiness. The bright acidity and chewy tannins contribute to a lengthy and balanced finish. Cellar 2026-2028.

### **2018 NEW ROUTINE**

**70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Syrah**

**Central Coast**

**250 cases, bottled February 2021**

Expressive notes of blueberries and dark red fruit effortlessly drift out of the glass. On the palate, this focused wine expresses itself as blackberries and reduced blueberries with tertiary notes of cola, spearmint and cedar. Persistent tannins and matched acidity meld into an elongated finish. Cellar 2028-2034.

Original Copy is a profound, stately and composed wine. Blue and red fruits prevail on the nose, with hints of underbrush, spearmint and eucalyptus, leading to flavors of dark chocolate covered blueberries, graphite and tart cranberry. The core of acidity is supported by sustained, youthful tannins which march down the blackberry-dominated palate in a wide column. Cellar 2028-2034.

## 2019 SERIOUS PLAY

A kaleidoscope of aromas greets you - rhubarb pie, toasted sagebrush, pomegranate, sun-dried tomatoes, lavender and sweet cherries. The impressive palate brings forth tart cherry, black fruits, plum and cranberry. There is a definite herbal edge (think bay leaf) that shifts towards sweeter spice notes: anise, sandalwood and peppercorns. A silky mouthfeel and a light, pleasant tannic grip leaves you wanting to enjoy glass after glass. Cellar 2025-2027.

## 2019 ZINFANDEL

**100% Zinfandel**

**Paso Robles**

**302 cases, bottled April 2021**

Notes of ripe red fruit and clove and nutmeg baking spices blend with a slight mintiness on the nose. The palate takes shape with concentrated reduced fruit characteristics - blackberry cobbler - as well as confectionary spice notes. The fruit is carried by a focused acid beam, raising a classic black pepper note with rounded, mellow tannins. Cellar 2024-2027.



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
