These wines are produced with minimal amounts of effective SO2, and are crafted without the use of added enzymes, water, acids, tannins or nutrients.

2018 VIOGNIER

100% Viognier, Hastings Ranch Vineyard, Adelaida District, 100 cases

This a sharp, tight expression of a grape that is too often overblown. The aromatics are honeysuckle, sweetness and creaminess: think brie with honey. Again, honey on the palate, with racy acid and a definite mineral streak, slightly saline. The wine was over-vintaged in concrete, and a full malolactic fermentation has built texture and further opened the aromatics. Bottled unfiltered and unfined, this is our best iteration of the wine to date. **Mixed club only**

2017 ODDLY NATURAL

45% Grenache, 41% Syrah, 14% Councise, Glenrose Vineyard, Adelaida District, 180 cases A deceptively savory and meaty nose (beef stock) explodes into insanely concentrated, candied red fruit that washes over the entire palate. A heavy wine, the tannins are wellrounded, supple and dense, and the whole wine seems to linger on the tongue for ages. **Reds club only**

2016 CONSTANT VARIABLE

47% Grenache, 26% Syrah, 14% Mourvèdre, 13% Counoise, Central Coast, 361 cases Punchy aromatics, driven by Grenache and Counoise, tend towards black and blue fruits, while Syrah and Mourvèdre components throw in some meatiness: jerked meats, soy and teriyaki, black peppercorns. All four grapes come together seamlessly on the palate to make for one of our best put-together wines to date.

2016 SOLO CONCERT

100% Syrah, Coast View Vineyard, Monterey County, 200 cases

A dark and brooding nose of slate, stem spice and hoisin sauce. The palate is dark-fruited, with Chinese plum-sauce and blackberry jam dominating, while roasting spices add complexity. The tannins are structured and firm, coming across a bit grippy. **All clubs**

2016 GRENACHE

100% Grenache, Paso Robles, 125 cases

Very rich, ripe red fruit pokes through on the aromatics: black cherry and strawberries. A little black pepper and savory rhubarb tempers the fruit. The strawberry comes back with a vengeance on the palate with herbal, tea characteristics: strawberry Snapple. **All clubs**

2017 PINOT NOIR

100% Pinot Noir, Rancho La Vina, Santa Rita Hills, 130cases

High-toned rustic elements of petrichor, seasoned firewood and wet cement bully the red fruit on the nose. Bright tart cherry and cranberry pushes forward on the palate, backed up by a clean line of acid. Rhubarb, sweet spice and nice stem tannin close out the finish. **All clubs**

2017 TRIUMVIRATE RESERVE ZINFANDEL \$52/\$41.60 6 btl/\$36.40 12 btl

100% Zinfandel, Bailey Ranch, Will's Hills, Osgood Farms, Paso Robles, 317 cases The best barrels selected from our best Zinfandel vineyard parcels. Always a sharp and focused nose of high-toned red fruits, cherry jam, brambles, and classic Zin pepper. A mean acid streak carries the wine from the front to back of the palate, supporting the bright but heavy fruit. The wine is nicely framed by subtle oak spice and aromatics. All clubs
