Boysenberry, blueberry, and fresh grapes prevail on the nose as well as violet and cola for our first estate New Routine. The palate explodes with black cherry, black pepper, baking spices and olive tapenade. Notable acid and tannins yield an herbal and well-balanced finish.

42% Cabernet Franc, 24% Petit Verdot, 23% Cabernet Sauvignon, 11% Merlot Adelaida District Paso Robles 300 cases. bottled February 2022

Notes of cinnamon, clove, leather, fresh baked pie crust and a hint of eucalyptus pave the way for a palate rich in black cherry, licorice and cardamom. The finish is spicy with harmonious acid and soft, integrated tannins.

Blueberry confit, violet, spearmint and black currant provide impressive aromas while the palate is full of spice, pepper and lavender earthiness. This full-bodied wine is structured and balanced, with fitting acid and velvety tannins.

Blackberry and black cherry combine with notes of bacon fat, dusty leather and rhubarb. The palate is teeming with black pepper, eucalyptus, mocha and Chambord while subtle tannins add to the lasting finish.
