Looking for a barbecue wine? With aromas of dark fruit preserves and black cherry tart, and blueberry on the palate. This wine is as savory and meaty as it is fruit-forward. These three dry-farmed vineyards provide everything we need for this wine: Bailey Ranch contributes body and structure. Will's Hills acid and amazing aromatics and Osgood ties them together with its velvety approachability. The result is a full-bodied wine where the fruit stays prominent on the long finish.
