On the nose, you will experience a balance of fresh fruit, cranberry sauce, with a hint of tobacco. The palate exhibits a spice profile which melds seamlessly with lush blue and black fruits. Medium tannins and balancing acidity provide a lingering and sophisticated finish. -Cellar through 2034.

Our Reserve Zinfandel: a selection of the best barrels from three dry-farmed, head-trained vineyards, and a wine that is distinctly Paso. Always high-intensity in every regard: soaring aromatics, sharp acidity, generous fruit, and strength. This is a classic Zinfandel expression from old-school sites, offering red berry compote, cherry jam, bramble, and cracked black pepper. -Cellar through 2029.



## **2023 HOMESTEAD HILL GRENACHE**

**100% Grenache**

Dominated by the fruit-driven freshness of strawberries and cherries, the nose evolves to candied fruit with a hint of white pepper. Bright acidity and structured tannins create the perfect, lingering finish of blackberries and cocoa. -Cellar through 2030.
