Thacher wine is produced with native yeast and bacteria, minimal effective SO₂, and crafted without added enzymes, water, acids, tannins, or nutrients.

These wines are all single varietal, vineyard-designated, from small lots, and the first three are making their debut.



2022 CABERNET PFEFFER
100% Cabernet Pfeffer
Siletto Vineyard- San Benito County

The aromatics begin with an enticing blend of fresh pomegranate and wild strawberry, complemented by herbaceous notes of rosemary and tomato leaf. On the palate, notes of cranberry and leather. Elevate your experience by decanting this bright, perfumed wine, or enjoy it slightly chilled.



2023 GRACIANO
100% Graciano
Hastings Ranch Vineyard- Adelaida District Paso Robles

Dark and brooding, with aromas of blue fruits such as blueberry, blackberry, and elderberry. The full palate is lush, with notes of black cherry preserves, plum sauce, and cranberries. This Spanish variety's lush mouthfeel and sophisticated tannins produce a lingering finish.



2024 MENCÍA
100% Mencía
Kentucky Ranch Vineyard- Adelaida District Paso Robles

Earth and wet stone, combined with baked fruit, drive this wine, leading to a palate of bright green tea, tart red cherry, and watermelon rind. This light-bodied wine, native to the Western Iberian Peninsula, finishes with solid, balanced tannins and green-apple-peel astringency.



2024 VALDIGUIÉ NOUVEAU
100% Valdiguié
Shell Creek Vineyard- Highlands District Paso Robles

This “nouveau” take on Valdiguié offers aromas of blackberry jam and candied red fruits, centered around a floral core. The pomegranate palate is zippy and refreshing. Serve chilled; it's perfect for pizza by the pool, on the patio, and at cocktail hour.
