2023 CONTROLLED CHAOS

With aromas of earth and red fruit leathers, this wine is bursting with huckleberry, blueberry, and rhubarb. The bright acidity and chewy tannins contribute to a lengthy and balanced finish. This wine is a perfect pairing for a rich, creamy truffle risotto.

An intoxicating nose of boysenberry crumble, pomegranate, transition to a slight flint aroma. Darker and more intense fruits then lead to a palate of savory cinnamon, blueberry, and cassis. This wine pairs well with a charcuterie board of cured meats and aged cheeses.

Notes of chocolate covered cherries, leather, and a hint of menthol pave the way for a palate rich in blackberry compote, Thai chili and cardamom. The finish is spicy with harmonious acid and soft, integrated tannins. Pair this wine with beef bourguignon.

On the nose this wine expresses blackberry pie, and violets with hints of eucalyptus at times. Balanced tannins introduce the palate, opening into dark fruits like black and blueberry, accompanied by violets, pepper, and a hint of baking chocolate. Open this at your family bbq.
